Offering individuals, couples, families, and groups a means of sharing and understanding disability issues affecting daily living.

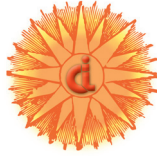
Our Vision

CIL program services are available to any person with a disability.



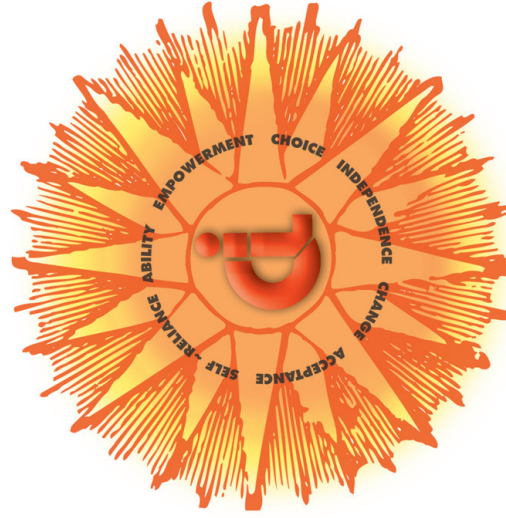
